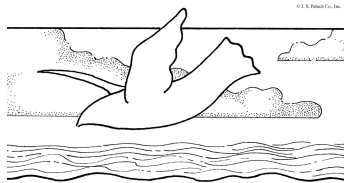
BAPTISM: Sundays at 12:30 pm preceded by instruction for the parents and godparents. Please call the rectory to register for classes.

He saved us through the bath of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit.— *Titus 3:5*

Dear Parishioners,

On Sunday 17th at the 11.30 a.m. Mass I am to be installed as Pastor of St. Dunstan's church by Bishop William Justice. There will be a reception in the parish center after the Mass. You are all invited.

Looking over the order of the ceremony I feel at bit daunted by the whole affair. First of all Bishop Justice commends me to you as your new pastor. Remember in the old days when you were getting married – the priest asked the congregation “if anyone objects to this marriage, speak now or forever be silent” – followed by a long pause. It must have felt like an eternity. If anyone even clears their throat I might consider taking a hike.

Then the Bishop goes on “Will you, with the help of the Holy Spirit, discharge without fail the office of priesthood as a worthy fellow worker with the Order of Bishops in caring for the Lord's flock?” Truly if the Holy Spirit gives me a hand I will do my best.

“Will you celebrate the mysteries of Christ reverently and faithfully, in accord with the tradition of the church and for the glory of God and the sanctification of the Christian people? I will if the Holy Spirit wants it.

“Will you carry out the ministry of the word worthily and wisely in preaching the Gospel and teaching the Catholic faith?”. Again, if the Holy Spirit gives me the wisdom, I will. “Will you unite yourself everyday more closely with Christ the High Priest, who offered himself to the Father as a pure sacrifice for us, and with Christ will you consecrate yourself to God for the salvation of all?” The Holy Spirit will have a lot to do.

The Bishop asks me then to promise respect and obedience? Over the years I have found it easy to respect and obey Bishops. These days it is getting a little tougher.

My brother priests are then asked if they will share the ministry with me? I hope they will agree.

I will be asked to be attentive to the needs of the Pastoral Council of the parish as the “voice of your people who will assist and counsel you in the ministry of the parish”. I certainly will appreciate their wisdom and counsel.

Then I profess the Creed. Additionally, I will be asked to believe everything contained in the Word of God, whether written or handed down in Tradition which the Magisterium sets forth as divinely revealed and again “to adhere with religious submission of will and intellect to the teachings of the Magisterium even if they do not intend to proclaim these teachings by a definitive act”. Again – with the help of the Holy Spirit.

If I was going to add anything to this ceremony I would add something about ‘conscience’. Of course it is presumed throughout when you talk about the help of the Holy Spirit. Please pray to God that I may be a good pastor.
