



Confirmation I – Mass Assignment

Preparing for Confirmation is an exciting time, and one of the integral parts of preparing for the Sacrament is involvement at Mass. I invite all of you to attend Mass regularly with your family, and talk about the readings and homily, and why the Mass is important to us as Catholics.

As a part of the Confirmation I program, you will be required to attend at least one Mass each month and turn in the attached Mass Worksheet to include: a one-page summary and reflection on the Bible readings and Homily, as well as a bulletin that is signed by the presiding priest.

It is important to remember that Confirmation is not just about getting through a program; it is about learning about and growing in your faith to nurture your love of and relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ. We meet Jesus in the most profound way in the Eucharistic celebration at the Mass, and it is ultimately Christ who guides us in our faith, and who we meet in the Sacraments.

Mass assignments will be due on the last Tuesday of each month! Please complete one worksheet for each Mass.

*****Important: If you are an Altar Server, you CANNOT use the Mass you serve as your monthly Mass Assignment. You MUST attend a separate Mass than the one at which you were an Altar Server in order for it to count as your monthly Mass Assignment*****
