CCD Calendars/Guidelines/General Information

During class today, CCD Calendars and Program Guidelines and Policies were distributed to go home. Please make sure that you keep the calendar available for easy reference. It can also be obtained on our website at www.saintdunstanchurch.org.

Catechists also discussed classroom rules as well as our program policies. Please make sure that you review these as well.

Our traffic policy was also included in the materials to go home. Please pay careful attention to our traffic procedures. Please enter our parking lot from the Broadway entrance and stay to the left of cones. Use the drive through line to drop off/pick up your child. Please park in designated spaces only.

Arrival/Dismissal

Students should not arrive any earlier than 10 minutes prior to the start of CCD. Students in Grades Kindergarten and First are ONLY dismissed when a parent/guardian comes directly to the classroom to pick them up. Parents are expected to be prompt in picking up their children. There will be a fee charged to parents who are consistently late in picking up their children or who have not arrived by 5:15 p.m. If, for any reason, you are delayed in picking up your child, please call the CCD Office to notify us of the problem. If your child needs to be dismissed from their class early, please write a note to the catechist explaining the reason and time the student needs to be dismissed. Please come directly to the CCD Office to pick-up your child.
